Everything in life is already 3-D, so why should you look at your chart in just 2-D anyway? It's like keeping one eye closed all the time without any good reason--you see everything distorted and incorrectly.

Before the 20th century, most astrologers always used 3-D "charts," called armillary spheres, like the one shown on the cover of this book. These allow you to see the true layout of the planets in the sky much better than any flat chart does. You can walk around it and look at the pattern layout from different angles or points of view. Sadly, such devices are hard to make (ergo, expensive) and even harder to set up and use. Little wonder people forgot all about them, especially once computers arrived on the scene.

Unconscious Habits Are the Worst

Thus, most people and most astrologers are unaware that they have developed a bad habit--namely, thinking that a 2-D chart is a good representation of the 3-D universe. You may already know that flat maps distort the earth's true shape. Well, charts do the same to our solar system.

Fortunately, now you at least know better. As soon as you start considering 100% of everything you do with astrology in 3-D, your comprehension, conclusions and decisions will improve enormously. And so will your life, your business, your relationships and your entire world.



Optical Illusions

As children we all delight in letting our eyes play tricks on us. That is part of the reason why we all love John Godfrey Saxe's famous poem, *The Blind Men and the Elephant*, based on an ancient fable told to his children when he was in India. Who can resist laughing at the six silly blind men arguing so sincerely about what an elephant really is? None of them has a clue about what the entire elephant really looks like.

However, as adults, we know an elephant when we see one. Or do we?

Take a second good look at how many legs our (star) wise elephant has in the above illustration, which is inspired by Roger Shepard's wonderful drawing, "*L' Egs-istential Quandary*". This is just one example of the fine art of optical illusion. Illusions exploit your eyes to play tricks on your mind. It's great and lots of fun!

A Broken Funny Bone

The only problem occurs when you really believe that what you see is 100% of reality. For example, if you believe that the horoscope chart you see on your monitor screen (or on paper) shows the sky at your birth time and place. That's not funny, but rather sad.

A Broken Chart


Of course, it's sad only if you know the difference between the cheap, fake imitation and the real McCoy. Well, that is the purpose of this book--to alert you to the optical illusion you may think is your horoscope.

The illustration below shows what you hopefully already realize whenever you look at your familiar horoscope. Regardless of what method you use to view your chart, you are doomed to failure and misunderstanding unless you "think outside the flat 2-D box."

3 Views of a Line

Your familiar chart has no depth, no third dimension, no back, no top and no side to it. If you print out your horoscope and then look at it from the side or top you see only the straight edges of the paper. Your flat chart is "hollow." It is playing tricks on you.

For millenniums, engineers, architects and artists have known that the only way to accurately represent a 3-D object, say a house, is to draw it from 3 perspectives--top, front and side. Your chart is an excellent way to draw your birth sky--but only one view of it. Want to see another?

Look at Reality

Common sense tells us the best way to understand your chart is to look at it in its original, true-life layout. The chart you look at should be a pure, unaltered, undistorted, mirror-image copy of the sky. After all, your eyes often tell you, for example, that the earth is flat and not a huge round sphere.

Consequently, the method you use to display your chart--a monitor screen or paper--should show the true positions and relationships of everything in the sky, without artificially distorting reality.

Not "WYSIWYG"

In the computer world, this is called "WYSIWYG" (What You See Is What You Get). Your astrology chart should show the exact shape and layout of your planets in the sky. All else is misleading. Understanding your self and life is hard enough without looking at charts that are distorted, misleading and wrong. You know that all flat maps distort the earth's true shape. Well, flat charts distort our solar system too.

Luckily for most astrologers, ~80% of your chart seen on a flat monitor screen (or paper) is indeed WYSIWYG.

Columbus Liked the Earth Not Flat

The exciting news is that ~20% of your flat chart is a serious distortion of the sky's true 3-D layout. If you are like most people and have never seen your chart in its true 3-D layout, get ready for some surprises. You may be thrilled to discover that ~20% of your chart is not at all what and where you thought it was. Your planets may be in different houses, signs, and with new aspects!

It will be a great step forward for astrology when more astrologers understand this critical, over-looked issue. Just look at Columbus, for example--he discovered a new world as soon as he realized the earth was not flat, but a big round sphere instead.

Ask Any Astronaut

Like us, our solar system and universe is quite three-dimensional. Just like the astronauts say it is. Therefore, the most accurate astrology analyzes your horoscope in 3-D, in its real life shape. This avoids the distortions, which occur when you squash a 3-D universe flat.

Armillary spheres, globes and other 3-D models, used by astrologers until the 20th century, show the layout of our solar system far more correctly than any flat 2-D chart or map ever can. Sadly, they are expensive and difficult to use--and so fell out of popular favor.

Seeing Your Chart in 3-D

Does Your Chart = You 100% ?


Your familiar horoscope chart is a simplified flat "picture" of the sky for the time and place you were born. Luckily, it symbolizes and explains your life pretty well. Yet imperfectly. Perhaps you have already wisely suspected that something was wrong with your chart.

Most likely, some of the classic astrology interpretations of your ecliptic chart don't "fit" you. Perhaps your forecasts or readings are "off" at times. Well, you were right all along! For sure your one flat chart needs improvement.

Fork Seen from 3 Views

Consider what a common table fork look like from three flat viewpoints. One flat view of a 3-D object, like a common fork, is very misleading. One view of your chart from the standard ecliptic perspective also misleads you. You may appreciate that the layout of the planets in the solar system is far more 3-D than an almost flat fork is.

If you only look at your chart from the flat viewpoint of the ecliptic, you will never comprehend your horoscope correctly.



How To Show Colors to Your Dog

It is said that dogs see in **black** and whife, not in **colors** like we do. What if you knew a person who could only see life that way? How would you show them or explain what **colors** are?

It is just as hard to show you your 3-D chart, since (I bet) you're reading this on your flat, 2-D computer screen. Everything you ever see on your screen is 100% 2-D. If it was 3-D, you could turn your monitor around and still see it.


Using Two Eyes Makes Good Sense

Clearly, you can not see anything on your monitor screen if you move to the side, the back, the top or the bottom of your monitor.

In our example of the common table fork, the best way to comprehend what a fork really looks like is to go get one, hold it in your hand, and turn it around to look at it from all three points of view. Of course, you can never do this in real life with our solar system.

Speaking with Forked Tongue

When you look at a picture or drawing of a fork on your flat monitor screen (or piece of paper), it can be very subtly misleading, like this clever illustration.



Imagine 3-D Chart Displays

Ideally, I want to use a 3-D holographic display of the cosmos for your birth, similar to those neat 3-D holograms seen in sci-fi movies, like "Star Wars." When such perfect models of our universe are available, and after we learn how to interpret them, our astrology insights should improve immensely. Such 3-D display tools may resolve many of the current controversies over house systems, forecast methods, zodiacs, etc. Again, it is impossible to show you what a 3-D display would be like unless you have a holographic computer monitor.

People, especially the best astrologers, realize how limited our understanding of a horoscope chart or forecast really is. Given the task, this is to be expected.

Using One Mirror Is Not Enough

Astrologers seek to understand life something quite complex. Flat charts further limit that ability, because they distort the astrological information shown. Little wonder that so few people consider astrology to be a 100% accurate, reliable source of information and advice. Astrology is still an "art," instead of a precise science like math, chemistry, physics or engineering.

In sincere efforts to improve their ability to help people, astrologers constantly try out new techniques and theories-some prove useful, most do not. The most valuable insights come from a better understanding of your basic chart, not from less critical factors.

Only the Planets Really Matter

The pattern and positions of your Sun, Moon, and planets are the ultimate core of all astrology. The reason they are so important is primitively simple. If just one of these were to disappear, we would all likely die. Now that's important.

If the Sun or Moon vanish, we'll know that instantly. If an inner planet, like Mercury...Saturn goes, we'll know that in a few years. If Uranus or Neptune go, we'll know in decades or centuries. Pluto's effect on us is still unknown.

Seeing Your Chart in 3-D

Trivial Pursuits

This is not true of all asteroids, comets, nodes, Arabic parts, hypothetical planets, fixed stars, and countless other astrology factors. Your life--no one's life--depends on them at all. They are so insignificant and trivial that they all could disappear and no one would know or care, except for astronomers and some astrologers.

This fact--the key importance of only the Sun, Moon and planets--is quite measurable. Our solar system affects us in two key ways--gravity and heat. Our Moon dominates our gravity (thus = our body and emotion), while our Sun is our heater (will and ego). The planets "musically" stabilize our solar orbit (pattern resonance entropy). Rogue Pluto is our cosmic shock absorber, helping tiny chaotic elements, such as asteroids, "blow off steam."

Stick with the Basics

Thus, what really defines your life is your Sun, Moon and the pattern of your planets--all else is inconsequential. To best understand how to improve your life using astrology, you must know the true positions of the Sun, Moon and planets in your chart (forecast...). This means viewing it in its true 3-D shape.

3-D Reality Matters

You might remember that the earth is tilted 23° on its axis relative to the Sun. This 3-D tilt is the reason we have different seasons. The tilt also makes it impossible to draw a precisely accurate 2-D chart of the sky. It's important.

Plus, planets wander all over the place--they don't uniformly move like the Sun. Moreover, their distance from you varies enormously over time--unlike the Sun.

Such 3-D reality is very important. Our worst floods occur when the Moon is on the ecliptic and nearest the earth. Also tidal waves, earthquakes and volcanoes relate to the 3-D positions of the planets. These 3-D facts are sometimes the difference between life and death. No single astrology chart can show this key real life information.

Stuck in 2-D

For now, you're stuck with a squashedflat horoscope and not some wonderful 3-D holographic display. Luckily you now know better--as all astrologers will some day. Happily, there is a way to compensate for the serious distortions that occur when we see 3-D reality on flat 2-D paper or displays.

Look at Your Chart—Twice

The solution is to look at your flat chart from two separate perspectives, angles, frames of reference, or points of view.

Architects, designers, engineers, and everyone else who needs accuracy always view 3-D objects from 2 or 3 perspectives: top, front and side. They don't want to build another leaning Tower of Pisa. The same principle is used in triangulation--2+ viewpoints are needed to locate the true position of anything on earth or in space.

Astrologers should learn from scientists and engineers and begin using two viewpoints, not just one, to show 3-D (since we don't yet have holographs).

Familiar Front View


Let's consider another typical thing--a car like you see everyday in real life in three dimensions. Now however, don't forget you're looking at it on just your flat monitor screen (not 3-D therefore). Most likely you have seen this front view of a car approaching you in the other lane as you drive along many times in your life.



You know reality when you see it--no one needs to tell you what is true and what is not--right? There is a blue car coming towards you in the other lane-no mistakes, no errors, no problems. You've got everything under control.

What you don't know, however, is what you would see if you looked at this car from another point of view, like from the side of the road. Here's that side view.

Side View SURPRISE!



Seeing Your Chart in 3-D

How many times has this happened to you? A slow car is in front of you; you pull out into the next lane to pass them, where you now see reality from another point of view. Surprise! You discover the other cars "hiding" behind the first car.

Do you know what you're missing by only looking at your chart from one limited point of view (the ecliptic)? What great surprises will you discover when you finally look at your chart from a second point of view? Two views will finally show your planets in their correct 3-D shape.

But what two viewpoints should you use? Well, it is usually best to stick to the tried and true fundamental "basics." What are the two most common, fundamental ways to look at life--to see things?

Use "Day" and "Year" Viewpoints

The two best "vantage" points to view your chart are from the perspectives of the Sun (= ecliptic) and the celestial equator (= right ascension, RA

These two views correspond to the two key earthly cycles you experience. You live every second of your life on a daily and yearly basis. This defines your total existence like nothing else. Your daily cycle comes from RA (rotating) motion while your yearly cycle comes from ecliptic (revolving) motion.

When you view your life from a daily and yearly perspective, you understand it best. That's why calendars are set up with days, weeks, months and years.

The 2 Key Motions You Live on Earth

Two key motions/cycles you always experience in life:

Rotation (= RA =day/night cycle)

Revolution (= Ecliptic = year cycle)

Home Sweet Home

The Earth is blue, the Moon is white, and you live on the brown-green dot in California. For simplicity, our Earth rotates only ~10 times per year, not 365 times. Polar axis tilt is left out, but eclipses, lunar phases and seasons are shown.

The same is true of your chart--you understand it best by viewing it from both RA (daily) and ecliptic (yearly) perspectives. This gives you close to a true-life, 3-D layout of the sky.

The only other cosmic cycles as key to your life as days and years are weeks and months, which result from our Moon's motion. Since its cycles are, mostly, part of our yearly (ecliptic) cycle, you don't gain much by viewing your chart from this third, lunar POV. Polar wobble (precession of the equinoxes) and galaxy spin only affect our evolution over eons, not your individual life, so mean nothing to you.

Open Both Eyes--Surprise

To best help my clients, I consider all astrology data (charts, forecasts, etc.) from both an ecliptic (yearly) and a right ascension (daily) viewpoint. If not, the raw information under review is limited, false and misleading. At times I even use a third (top) view of your chart. Most likely you already familiar with your chart from one perspective, the ecliptic (Ec). Most astrologers and software only use this one point of view.

A "New" Happy Birthday

So, expect some big surprises when you see your "new" right ascension (RA) chart. The new information you learn by examining your chart using both exciting displays will revolutionize your self-awareness.

Indeed, you get closest to the whole truth by combining these two viewpoints of your chart into one single conclusion. This also applies to all your astrology-self-discovery, relocation, forecasting, compatibility, horary, medical, esoteric, meteorological, etc. If you did this with any flat image of the earth, for example, you would instantly realize the earth is spherical, not flat.

I have developed many useful astrology techniques to help me understand your life. Yet, using both ecliptic and right ascension displays is the most useful. I analyze your life in 3-D, not flattened into some misleading shape.


The wonderful improvements in the lives of my clients are the best proof of the benefits of this technique.

AstroCartography Maps Use RA

Right ascension is actually quite common. Solar and primary arc direction forecasts, astrocartography maps, and cyclo-cartography mapforecasts use RA to show where things truly are. What works so well for these proven techniques also offers you the best insights into your own life.

Bad Habits Limit Us

Sadly, most software shows your RA and ecliptic charts in very different ways. Ecliptic charts are in pie format:

In contrast, your RA chart is only shown in a 0-360° format--without any houses, signs, or Ascendant and MC axes.



(expand chart size to improve clarity)

This illogical bad habit started because astronomers use 0-360° of RA to measure the sky, while most modern astrologers are stuck on only ecliptic. These two different formats are why you have not realized how important your RA chart is before now.

Compare Apples to Apples

There is good reason to look at your chart in RA using a traditional "wheel" format with signs, houses, aspects, and your Ascendant. It helps you realize that our solar system is not flat. That is why for centuries all astrologers used astrolabes--to remind them that one flat chart display is misleading--wrong.

One look at your RA chart, in the same wheel layout as your Ec chart, will soon convince you to always analyze your chart in its original 3-D shape. When I developed my own patented astrology software back in 1990-96 for my private counseling practice, I included this critical capability. My software shows me your chart from both the ecliptic and RA point of view.

Seeing your chart in 3-D, by using two perspectives, helps me best understand the actual experiences, struggles, and opportunities you experience. I have learned how to integrate these two "pictures" into one whole understanding of your life. As a result my advice to clients is far more accurate and useful.

Sadly, I developed my own software for home computer use--not the Internet.

Seeing Your Chart in 3-D

Know Thyself

The best way to appreciate the value of two viewpoints is by considering your own personal chart in 3-D and those of your friends and family.

After you check out your own charts on my website, then take a look at the charts of some famous celebrities (see <u>Appendix B</u>). Taken together the ecliptic and RA charts for these celebrities help us understand these people much better.

Planets Changing Signs

Nothing makes the value of 3-D chart analysis more blatantly obvious than planets changing signs when seen from our two points of view. As an example of this, say your planet "X" is in Aries in your familiar ecliptic chart. Yet in sharp contrast, planet "X" is in Pisces in your right ascension chart.

That is a big, clear change, since Aries is extremely different than Pisces. Both are true however--your planet "X" will manifest in both ways, even though the Aries effects are very dissimilar from the Pisces effects. You have a strange blend called "PAirsiceess".

Now, if only the ecliptic perspective were true and sufficient, then the standard interpretation of your planet "X" in Aries would describe you 100% correctly.

What you will discover, however, is that any interpretation of your planet "X" in Aries does NOT describe you 100% correctly--just only ~50% right. The classic interpretation of your planet "X" in Pisces also describes ~50% of your life and personality. Both are partially true and accurate.

Ecliptic Interpretations Fall Short

This proves the need for 3-D analysis. You must look at your chart from two perspectives to know where your planets really are. Were only the ecliptic POV sufficient, then the classic interpretation of your ecliptic chart would fit you 100% correctly. It will not.

3-D analysis lets you see how a planet on a cusp is sometimes, in reality, in both signs--and thus manifests a blend of both effects. Other times however that planet is in reality in just the same sign by both viewpoints--no cusp blend of sign effects manifests at all.

Sun is like Clockwork

All planets but one move so irregularly that you must precisely calculate your chart by ecliptic and RA to know if any planets are in two signs at once. The Sun, however, is simple.

If you were born within a day of these dates--1/19, 2/18, 4/22, 5/22, 7/22, 8/22/, 10/24, and 11/23--then your Sun is in one sign by ecliptic and in a different sign by RA. Cool!

The famous celebrities in <u>Appendix B</u> are born on these dates. Their ecliptic charts alone fail to adequately explain their lives and personalities. However, their two charts together clearly explain these celebrities 100% correctly.

In addition, there are some examples of celebrities whose Moon or some other key planet changes signs when viewed from two POV's.

These examples may help you finally understand why the standard, classic interpretations of your (ecliptic) chart alone do not fit you perfectly.

Seeing Your Chart in 3-D

Alternative 3-D Approaches

Needless to say, I am certainly not the only astrologer who has ever thought of looking at charts in three dimensions. As mentioned earlier, astrologers from about the 12th to the 20th century used spherical globes to simulate the 3-D positions of the planets.


Unfortunately, such devices are not precise enough to represent the exact degree positions of your planets by sign, much less your chart's Ascendant and houses. This, and their high cost, are the reasons they fell into disuse.

Recent computers falsely promise, but don't yet deliver real 3-D images. Using optical illusions, they trick you into thinking you're seeing things in real 3-D. Yet you're still looking at your chart on a flat 2-D monitor screen even if your imagination says you're seeing a 3-D holograph. You are not.

Too Innovative and Confusing

Other than my approach of using two perspectives to show 3-D, the other modern idea shows your chart spread out along a elliptical shape as shown below. This idea has deserves an A+ for originality. Still, such a layout is totally new and therefore unfamiliar to everyone. Plus, this display method is quite complex to use for forecasts, compatibility charts, etc. I don't use it, but respect its attempt to show reality.

Instead I prefer using two views of your familiar chart to depict 3-D. This is how all scientist-engineer-artists depict spatial reality--by showing the top, front and/or side views. No new layout to have to learn. Your familiar chart is still your chart, except now you do have a second, (more or less) similar chart, which also describes you and your life. Only holographs of the future will do a better job of explaining reality.



Seeing Your Chart in 3-D

When to Use a Third View


It's sometimes essential to see three views of your chart--top, front and side-to know the true layout of your planets. This is most often the case with Pluto since it wanders far from the ecliptic and from the celestial equator (= RA).

All your planets, except for your Sun, can actually be in different houses than shown by both your ecliptic and RA viewpoints. While this only occurs ~20% of the time, it's very important if the Ascendant (and Desc) are involved.

Local Horizon Chart

This is why I always consider your "Local Horizon" Chart for your current or future location. Here's an example: The straight line in middle of the LHC below is the horizon for the time and place under consideration. Planets above this line are in houses 7-12, while planets below it are in houses 1-6. Planets right on this horizon line are rising (East) or setting (West).

In this example, the Sun (\mathbb{Q}) is far below the horizon line hidden from visible sight. Saturn (\mathbb{W}), Jupiter (\mathbb{V}) and Neptune (\mathbb{Y}) are far above the horizon. The Moon (\mathbb{R}) and Pluto (\mathbb{Z}) are a few degrees above the horizon line. The Moon is in 12h conjunct the (Eastern) Ascendant while Pluto is in 7h conjunct the (Western) Descendant. This means the Moon affects 12h matters while Pluto powerfully affects 7h matters.


More than One Way to Skin a Chart

Your astrocartography map (by RA) actually contains the same information as your "Local Horizon" chart. In fact, if your RA map shows all your optional aspect lines (trines, squares, sextiles, semi-sextiles), then it shows the true house "positions" of all your planets.

The problem with such a map is that it's over-crowded with lines and very confusing when you display all the planet aspects. I wish map software displayed only the 12 house lines along with the planets properly positioned. It's only easy to understand a map if you display a few lines--namely your planets on or near the (East or West) horizon--in other words in 1h vs. 12h or 6h vs. 7h. These are of course the same key planet conjunct Ascendant or Descendant astrocartography lines that Jim Lewis popularized.

In contrast, your "Local Horizon" chart is crystal clear. It shows this critical horizon (Ascd-Desc) information in a very obvious manner--but, sadly, that's all it shows (houses 1, 6, 7 and 12), not all 12 of your chart's houses.

Fortunately that is good enough to locate your "Paradise" most of the time.

How Ecliptic and RA Differs


Of course, you can also "lose" some really "positive" positions, too. Yet, take heart! Remember that you are NOT your ecliptic chart OR your RA chart, but a blended combination of both. You will love evaluating your chart (forecast, etc.) in this new informative light.

Moon "Rise" by Ecliptic

Your Eyes See RA, Ecliptic and Horizon

When you look at the real Sun, Moon, Mars, etc. with your own eyes, you see them in their true 3-D positions. The positions and motions of your planets are a complex combination of the earth's rotational spin (measured by RA, right ascension), the earth's revolution around the Sun (= ecliptic) and the curvature of the earth (shown by local horizon).

If you watch a planet rise, peak and set during any day, your eyes exactly see what an RA chart shows. In sharp contrast, an ecliptic chart "lies" to you, seriously distorting this real daily motion. Instead, an ecliptic chart shows your planets from a "yearly" point of view. Here is an example.



Seeing Your Chart in 3-D


Imagine that you're watching a nice Moon rise on the Eastern horizon. Ten minutes after it rises, you calculate a horoscope for that exact moment. Luckily you have <u>Astrolog</u> and so can easily view the chart from both ecliptic and Right Ascension perspectives (thanks to Walter Pullen!).

Get ready for a very big surprise!

WYSIWYG vs. NOT

In both charts you see a horizontal line, labeled Asc and Des, which represents the horizon. The Moon (\mathbb{R}) is on the East horizon (Asc, left side of chart). You are located in the very middle of the chart.

Houses 1h-6h depict the sky beneath the horizon under the ground where you stand. You can't see the part of sky there through the earth of course. Houses 7h-12h depict the visible sky above the horizon that you can see.

Notice that the ecliptic chart shows the Moon in 1h, <u>not</u> visible beneath the horizon. The RA chart shows the Moon in 12h, which <u>is</u> visible above the horizon.

You blink, pinch yourself, and look again at the real Moon. No, you're not imagining things. Yes, the actual real Moon is indeed visible above the horizon, which means it truly is in 12h. In this particular case, the RA chart shows what you see with your own two eyes. The ecliptic chart is dead wrong--the Moon is <u>not</u> in 1h invisible below the horizon. In reality it is in 12h.

Famous Celebrity Charts

Planets, which change signs when seen from the two key points of view, are the best proof of the value of 3-D chart analysis.

These charts of famous celebrities truly illustrate this point. They have planets in two signs, one by ecliptic and one by RA. Their ecliptic charts alone fail to adequately explain their lives and personalities. Only their two charts taken together clearly explain these celebrities 100% correctly.

These examples may help you finally understand why all the standard interpretations of your ecliptic chart (forecast, etc.) alone do not describe nor fit you perfectly.

Explanation of the Charts

Expand the charts to see them better.

To help you distinguish, the ecliptic charts are boxed in gold, since the ecliptic is the Sun's plane or path in the sky. The right ascension charts are boxed in dark blue, since RA is the earth's equator and polar axis (projected onto the sky).

The aspect lines shown are: red = "stressful" squares, semi-squares, etc. green = "easy" trines and sextiles purple = "mixed" quintiles, etc.


3-D Conclusions

Most charts have exact birth times using two different sources. Yet, even a large error in the birth time would not shift any planet(s) from being in two signs to being just in one sign in both ecliptic and RA. Thus the conclusions you draw by viewing the two charts of these celebrities are valid regardless of birth time accuracy.

Birthplace and Relocated Natal Charts

All charts show the Ascendant, MC and houses for the natal birthplace only--they are not relocated. If you relocate the natal chart (= RNC) of these celebrities to the key relevant locations in their lives (such as Hollywood for actor/actresses, etc.), the value of our 3-D chart analysis (and RNC's) is even more blatant. (see, "*Finding Paradise*".)

Kenny Rogers--RIGHT ASCENSION (RA) Chart





United States of America--RIGHT ASCENSION (RA) Chart






Arnold Schwarzenegger and Maria Shriver--Ecliptic Comparison

Arnold Schwarzenegger and Maria Shriver--Right Ascension Comparison
















